



Canopy Set-up Guide

1. Lay out canopy in your desired area. Making sure that you do not see the tie down ropes for the center poles. They should be under the tent; this makes sure that the tent is not upside down.
2. Pull the ropes out from the perimeter of the tent. Approximately 6' from the side of the tent is where you nail the stakes in. Every rope has one stake to go around the tent. Making sure that the stakes are secure. The rope makes a loop. Place the loop around the stake. The plastic slider is what you are going to use for tightening the tent later.
3. Start putting the center poles together. The center poles are made up of 2 large bottom poles and 1 smaller pole. Before you join the 2 larger poles make sure that you look at the bottom of the pole to make sure that there is no dirt inside it.
4. With the remaining poles join together 1 small and 1 large this makes the side pole. Place them around the tent.
5. Start putting the side poles in the tent through the grommets. Then insert the center poles through the leather ring.
6. The more you keep the canopy square the better it will look. By pulling on the plastic slider you can tighten the tent. Last tie down the rope around the center pole and you are finished.
